



Mercury insanity - autism

In the early 1980's approximately one in 2,500 children were autistic. In 2003, the number was one in 250. This year, 2004, it is being reported at 1 in 133. What is happening?

If a terrorist was stealing the minds of so many of our children it would be all out war.

Although a problem such as autism may well not have a simple answer, mercury toxicity to the brain seems to be the primary cause. Mercury in doses exceeding "safe or recommended doses" is routinely given to newborns, infants, and toddlers in their immunizations. In fact many parents can point to the extreme change in their children's behavior to immediate post immunization. Mercury definitely destroys neurons.

The fact that most infants survive apparently unscathed, while others have their minds destroyed is testament that some are apparently unable to deal with the metal toxin, which inability could be of genetic or environmental origin or both. Autistic children do not have mercury in their hair or finger nails... they can't excrete it. Normal children have mercury in their hair and fingernails. Our genetic inheritance determines our ability to remove mercury from the brain.

Imagine a child that has genetically inherited the brain protein that cannot grab mercury. This persons mother has mercury fillings in her mouth, that are constantly exposing her to mercury vapor. It is possible that to fight nausea during pregnancy, she is treated with an anti-nausea injection that is preserved with mercury. Children are typically born with 75% higher mercury in their placental blood than the mother. Upon birth, the tiny 6 pound newborn is given an anti-hepatitis vaccine injection, containing mercury, approx. 70 times what the EPA considers a reasonably safe level for their weight. And then there are the immunizations to follow. Mercury toxicity itself inhibits the bodys production detoxifying agents. Could the cause of autism be this simple?

There is not a history of Autism before the 40's, before immunizations. There was a dementia in children that resembled autism called pinks disease. Pinks disease was totally eliminated when it was discovered it was caused by rubbing a mercury compound on their teething gums.

Do not look for any help from the government. The CDC has studied the problem and has concluded that mercury is not involved in the autism.

Immunizations come in single dose vials or multi-dose vials. Single dose vials generally do not contain mercury as a preservative. Always insist on single dose vials, they have a glass top that breaks off. (A little more expensive). Demand to read the label, or papers that come with the immunization to check for mercury, ie; thimerosal.
